RISEPTIS report recommendation 1:

- stimulate interdisciplinary research, technology development and deployment that addresses the trust and security needs in the Information Society. The priority areas are:
 - (1) Security in (heterogeneous) networked, service and computing environments, including a trustworthy Future Internet;
 - (2) Trust, Privacy and Identity management frameworks, including issues of meta-level standards and of security assurances compatible with IT interoperability;
 - (3) Engineering principles and architectures for trust, privacy, transparency and accountability, including metrics and enabling technologies (e.g. cryptography);
 - (4) Data and policy governance and related socio-economic aspects, including liability, compensation and multi-polarity in governance and its management.”
